

IMPORTANT - READ CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLATION

WARNINGS!

Drowning Hazard – Always securely close the rain barrel cover to avoid a child drowning. Never use a rain barrel without the cover securely closed or with a damaged, cracked, warped, or broken cover. Never permit children to play on, in, or near a rain barrel. Never place rain barrel near a deck, stairs, chair, or other structures or items that would allow a child to climb above, onto, or into the rain barrel.

Water Contamination Hazard – Never let people or animals drink water from the rain barrel. Never use for cooking or washing or any way that may result in ingestion of the water. Water in rain barrel may become stagnant or contaminated. Drinking rain barrel water may cause serious illness or death. Use rain barrel water only for watering plants or outdoor cleaning uses.

Tipping Hazard – Rain barrel may tip over and injure people or damage property if not properly set-up. Never place rain barrel on any surface that is not flat and even. Always use a solid surface under the rain barrel. The placement and preparation of the area where your rain barrel will stand must be level and provide solid support.

Electrical Hazard – If downspout contains heating cables, there is a potential electrocution or fire hazard during installation.

CAUTION!

Installation Hazards – Rain barrels are for water collection and outdoor use only. No other uses are recommended. Downspout edges may be sharp. Wear protective gloves when cutting and handling downspouts to avoid cuts or scratches. Always wear safety glasses when doing cutting or drilling to prevent eye injuries. Protect the home's siding with a sheet of wood inserted between the downspout and the siding to prevent damage.

Please read through all instructions before beginning the installation of this product. If improperly installed and/or maintained, there is potential for damage to your home or possible injury or death. 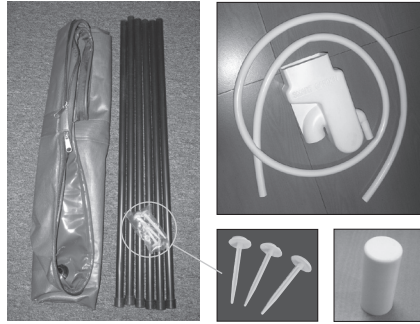

BOX CONTENTS

Check your box to make sure you have the following materials:

- 1 Smart Rain Barrel
- 6 Support Poles
- 1 Water Diverter
- 1 Hose (6 ft. length)
- 1 Deactivator Plug
- 3 Ground Stakes

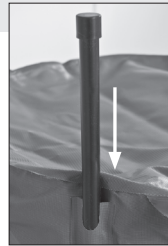


TOOLS NEEDED:

- Tin shears or sharp scissors
- Hammer or rubber mallet
- Protective gloves and eyewear

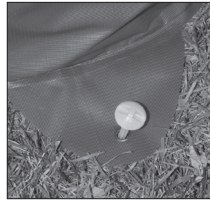
SMART RAIN BARREL ASSEMBLY

1. Unfold and open your Smart Rain Barrel.
2. Make sure lid is completely zippered and turn the barrel upside down.
3. Carefully insert all 6 support poles into provided sleeves.
4. Push all poles in completely so the caps are level with the bottom of the barrel.



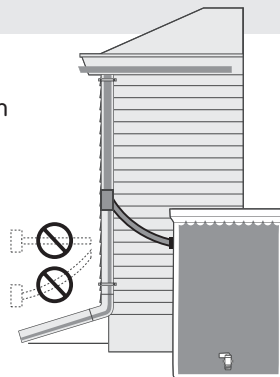
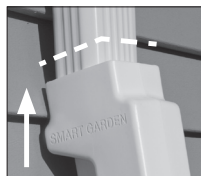
MOUNTING SMART RAIN BARREL TO THE GROUND

1. Position your Smart Rain Barrel near one of your gutter downspouts. The surrounding area should be clear of cement or any other material where the stakes can't be used. **NOTE:** Make sure you position it so the distance between the barrel and the downspout does not exceed the 6 foot diverter hose.
2. Using a hammer or rubber mallet, pound the 3 stakes into the mounting flaps on the bottom of the barrel. The ground may be soft enough for you to simply push the stakes in the ground.



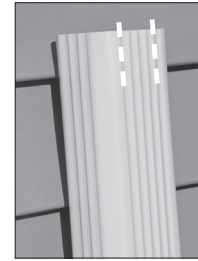
WATER DIVERTER INSTALLATION

1. Select an area of your downspout to install the diverter. It is recommended to position it a minimum of 6" above the rain barrel. Unlike other styles, this one will not work properly and will result in water overflow if it is level or lower. Make a horizontal cut in the downspout of your gutter. Move over bottom of downspout and push in the diverter over the top of downspout.

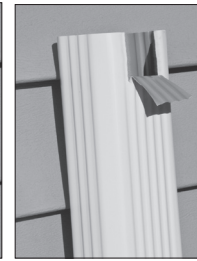

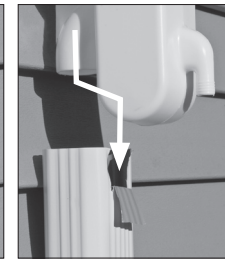
2. Make two 2" to 3" long vertical cuts into the bottom portion of downspout. **NOTE:** It is important that the two cuts match the width of the extension tube on the back of the diverter. This is so the back of the diverter fits into the downspout.
3. Carefully fold down the area you just cut. **NOTE:** Metal may be sharp, so you should wear protective gloves when handling.
4. Reattach bottom of downspout to the side of your home so the diverter fits snug into the slot you just created.
5. a. Attach the tube to the front nozzle on the diverter. Cut the tube so the connection to the rain barrel is as straight as possible without any drooping. b. For winter storage, remove the tube and place deactivator plug over the diverter nozzle.



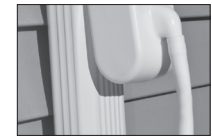

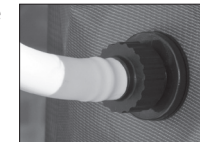

6. a. Attach tube to the side connector nozzle on the rain barrel. b. You also have the option of removing the nozzle and directly inserting the tube into the connector. Your Smart Rain Barrel is now completed.

USING YOUR SMART RAIN BARREL

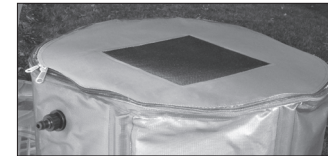
Easily attach a garden hose to the bottom connector. Remove nozzle, attach garden hose, then open the water flow valve. Now you're ready to water your garden.



Use connector on other side to attach a second Smart Rain Barrel. **NOTE:** Keep cap on when not in use.



Unzip the top lid for direct access to water. It holds up to 60 gallons.



WINTER STORAGE

Make sure all water is drained from your Smart Rain Barrel and detach from diverter and downspout. Remove support poles, and fold up for convenient storage.
